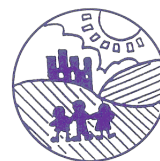
Aspire Class will be visiting the Coop in Matlock to identify and purchase Fairtrade products on Wednesday 8th March.

Class: Aspire

Teacher: Mrs Edwards

We are learning:

Literacy *(Reading and Writing)*

Phonics – the children are split into groups to practise their phonemes and use them in their reading and writing.

Acrostic poem: We will be starting our topic by creating a Fairtrade acrostic poem using key vocabulary linked to the new topic.

Persuasive language: We will be using persuasive language to create a 'Buy Fairtrade' poster.

Explanation text: We will look at the journey of a bar of chocolate and explain the process of how chocolate is made.

Recipes: We will be writing ingredients lists and the method for baking Fairtrade chocolate.

Communication and

Language *(Speaking and Listening)*

Each child will have a perfect partner who they will talk to during discussions, problem solving and reasoning activities, to share their ideas with before they feed back to the class.

Physical Development *(PE)*

We will be focusing on dance activities including travelling in space, moving to the rhythm, travelling and still shapes, keeping balance, and following sequence in group work.

The children will also take part in yoga once a week.

PSED *(Personal, Social and emotional Development)*

Through our Fairtrade topic we will be discussing fairness and equality in relation to all aspects of life.

Our learning is around the topic Fairtrade.

Our topic will end with a 'Great Fairtrade Bake Off'.

Expressive Arts and Design *(Art, D&T and Music)*

We will be designing packaging for the cakes made in our 'Great Fairtrade Bake Off' using our 3D maths knowledge.

We will be learning and singing a West African song and will be adding in percussion instruments.

Mathematics

We will be learning to tell the time to 5 minutes.

We will revisit partitioning and consolidate column addition and subtraction.

We will be finding halves, quarters, thirds and exploring equivalent fractions.

We will collect data on our favourite food and represent this as tallies, pictograms and bar charts.

We will be revising mental methods of calculation for addition, subtraction and times tables.

Understanding of the World

(History, Geography, Science, RE, ICT)

We will locate hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the equator.

We will compare Matlock with a village in India called Chembakolli by looking closely at similarities and differences and the physical and human features.

Through position and direction, we will be naming the seven continents and five oceans.

We will learn about the festival of Easter.
