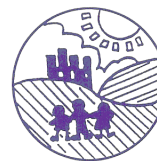

Class: Endeavour

We are learning:

Literacy (*Reading and Writing*)

Spelling and grammar: The children will be learning spelling, punctuation and grammar rules to apply to their reading and writing.

Myths and legends: We will explore the story of Theseus and the Minotaur to produce a diary and report using Green Screen technology

Poetry: We will be creating Greek Haiku poems from the myth and legend stories that we experience throughout the topic.

Y6 Revision: Y6s will be revising for the SPAG and reading papers in small focus groups.

Communication and

Language (*Speaking and Listening*)

Each child will have a perfect partner who they will talk to during discussions, problem solving and reasoning activities, to share their ideas with before they feed back to the class.

Physical Development (PE)

Through athletics, we will develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance. We will compare performances with previous ones and demonstrate improvement to achieve a personal best.

PSED (*Personal, Social and emotional Development*)

Through our topic, the children will be exploring democracy and dictatorships.

Our learning is focused on how Ancient Greece has influenced our lives today.

Our topic will end in a sculpture showcase.

Expressive Arts and Design (*Art, D&T and Music*)

We will be researching pottery styles and themes from Ancient Greece in order to plan and create a patterned clay structure.

Mathematics

We will be learning how to identify and measure different angles.

Through our sculpture and computing lessons, we will consolidate our knowledge of angles, shapes and patterns.

We will be learning about compound shapes and how to find area and perimeter.

We will be solving geometry problems using the knowledge we have gained.

Understanding of the World

(*History, Geography, Science, RE, ICT*)

We will be exploring how Ancient Greece has influenced the Western world today.

We will be using Logo software to write programs, which create repeating patterns using shapes, lines and angles.
